You must have a good working knowledge of your sewing machine prior to class.

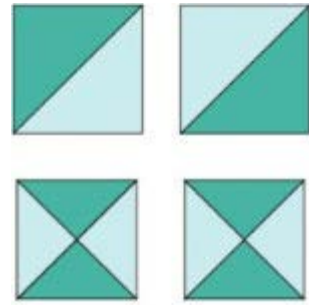
Triangle Basics

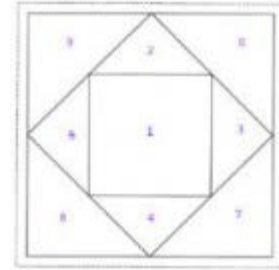


Foundation Paper Piecing Basics
